MODERN LANGUAGE POLICY FOR LATE ENTRANTS

- ◆ Learning a foreign language is compulsory up to GCSE unless there is a disapplication (e.g. Dyslexia, EAL).
- ◆ If required, girls coming into Year 8 or Year 9, will be offered additional help to catch up with French. After a period of assessment, if they are deemed to be able to profit from this additional teaching it will continue and their needs will be readdressed periodically.
- ◆ If the girl is unable to catch up she will discontinue French and start Spanish in Year 8.
- ◆ Pupils coming in Year 10 will be assessed and offered one extra period of tuition if required for the rest of the year in French and/or Spanish
- ◆ The school can facilitate private lessons in German as a third language as required.
- ◆ Pupils coming to Wychwood School with a first language other than English are advised and encouraged to take qualifications in this.
