MODERN LANGUAGE POLICY FOR LATE ENTRANTS

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- ◆ Learning a foreign language is compulsory up to GCSE unless there is a disapplication (e.g., Dyslexia, EAL).
- ◆ If required, girls coming into Year 8 or Year 9, will be offered additional help to catch up with French or Spanish. After a period of assessment, if they are deemed to be able to profit from this additional teaching it will continue, and their needs will be readdressed periodically.
- ◆ Pupils coming in Year 10 are offered extra tuition, if required, provided by the language assistant (Any extra lesson will be paid as private tuition)
- ◆ The school can liaise with tutors, should the student be interested in private lessons in German, Mandarin, Cantonese, Latin, etc. Students can sit this specific examination through the school registration system provided by the exam officer.
- ◆ Pupils coming to Wychwood, Oxford with a first language other than English are advised and encouraged to take qualifications in this.
