Course Overview

This two-week summer camp will immerse you in the world of musical theatre, offering a comprehensive and exciting exploration of singing, acting, and dancing! Whether you're a seasoned performer or just discovering your potential, this course is designed to nurture your talents and build your confidence in a supportive and creative environment.

About the course:

- Daily workshops:
 - o **Voice:** learn proper vocal technique, breathing exercises, and how to navigate different musical styles.
 - o **Acting:** develop your stage presence, character creation skills, and explore improvisation techniques.
 - o **Dance:** learn various dance styles, including musical theatre choreography, with a focus on coordination, rhythm, and expressing emotions through movement.
- Masterclasses: gain insights from professional actors and dancers through interactive workshops.
- Showcase your talent: perform in a final showcase in front of an invited audience.
- **Collaborative learning:** this course fosters teamwork and collaboration, allowing you to connect with like-minded individuals who share your passion for performing.
- Perform numbers from musicals including: Les Misérables, Matilda, Made in Dagenham, Wicked etc...

Steve is an acclaimed playwright and drama teacher. Over the years, Steve has been a teacher, actor, comedian, playwright, singer, sports coach, holiday camp entertainer and director of huge theatrical youth productions. Steve has a degree in Drama from Dartington College of Arts and a teaching certificate from Leicester University.

He ran a theatre company for several years and has played Toad in *Wind in The Willows* seventy-five times! Most recently, he was Head of Performing Arts at Queen's College in Taunton where he directed many musicals including *Made in Dagenham*, *Sister Act and Suessical*.

Millie's passion for performance began at the tender age of two, when she first started dancing. She achieved her Grade 8 qualification in Musical Theatre aged 10 and her Grade 8 Classical Singing qualification at the age of 13. She secured a silver medal for Musical Theatre at the All-England Theatre Festival and reigned as the Southwest Champion for an impressive four years straight.

Most recently, Millie graced the prestigious West End stage, portraying the character of "Young Jenny" (Michael Ball's daughter) in Andrew Lloyd Webber's musical, *Aspects of Love*. Her diverse performing experience also includes playing Hedgehog in the 2016 production of *The Wind in the Willows* and participating in the Debbie Isitt-directed *Nativity*.

Excursions

- **London:** walking tour of the capital city, taking in famous landmarks such as Buckingham Palace, The Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, The London Eye and The Globe Theatre.
- Bath: Tour of this stunningly beautiful, UNESCO world heritage site city. Tour will include visit to the Roman Baths and Royal Crescent.
- Walking Tour of Oxford: explore the spires of Oxford, including the iconic Radcliffe Camera, the Sheldonian Theatre, The University Church of St. Mary's, the Bridge of Sighs and Bodleian library.
- Wembley Stadium Tour: Walk in the footsteps of legends and experience the magic of Wembley Stadium with this behind-the-scenes tour!
